## LIFE GROUP SERMON SUMMARY QUESTIONS

These questions are for the **October 2, 2016** sermon, "The Worthy One." Please read the sermon passage (Revelation 5:1-14) together out loud.

## Sermon Outline:

IN PREPARATION FOR COMMUNION, NOTE . . .

- 1. The revelation of Jesus Christ (1-7)
- 2. The response to Jesus Christ (8-14)
  - A. Fall on our faces; sing a new song.
  - B. "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain."
  - C. Every creature worships, every tongue confesses, every knee bows before God.

## Life Group Discussion Questions

- Based on #1, above: Only Jesus Christ is worthy to open the sealed will and testament that God the father holds in his hand. No one else. We need Jesus Christ. No one else has the ability or authority to open the scroll. Do you recognize your need of Jesus Christ? How does Jesus' sufficiency and presence change the way you pray for your children? How does it change the way you prioritize your daily calendar? How does he change the way you think about heaven?
- Based on #1, above: Jesus is the lion of the tribe of Judah (Gen 49:8-10). He is powerful, free and untamable. Yet he always does what he knows to be good. Is this untamable Lion prominent in your life? Or preeminent? How can we be sure?
- 3. Based on #2, above: When we see the greatness of the incomparable one and the smallness of ourselves (the "incapable ones"), our right response is to fall on our faces and sing. Do you respond like that? How is your life bowed before him? How is it not?
- 4. Based on #2, above: Talk about a moment in your life when you came to realize that you were not bowed before him in gratitude. How did God humble you? How did he get your attention? How did he help you realize the greatness of his Son and your own smallness? Where might God be at work similarly in your life today?
- 5. What is your absolute favorite song that helps you enter into the worship of Jesus Christ? Why is it special to you? Is it a "new" song? Why should we be easily edified by new songs?
